Student Research Symposium Submission Procedures and Guidelines

- 1. Submissions are open to all CEHD undergraduate and graduate students.
- 2. Submissions are accepted only via the online submission portal.
- 3. Submissions may be submitted by an individual presenter or group. Please submit only one proposal per group and list every contributor.
- 4. Participant registration and attendance is required. All presenting authors of accepted submissions are expected to register and attend the symposium.
- 5. Submissions may be submitted for either oral and/or poster presentation format. Students not selected for oral presentation will be encouraged to participate in the poster session.

Please note: Oral presentation slots are limited. Those selected may be asked to participate in a one-on-one coaching session to refine their presentation.

- 6. Submissions must include the following:
 - ORAL PRESENTATION SUBMISSION:
 - Title (20 words or fewer)
 - Abstract (120 words or fewer)
 - Research Project Summary (500 words or fewer)
 - Please seek faculty guidance if unsure of the appropriate elements of a research project summary for a particular discipline.
 - List of presenters, including full name, Mason email, G#, student classification, and program(s) of study
 - Name of faculty or staff contributors (if applicable)

 - Name of faculty or staff contributors (if applicable)
 - Abstract not required
- 7. Submissions will be reviewed and evaluated. Students will be notified by Friday, March 6, on the status of their proposal submission.
