Description:

Principal Duties of Camp Voyager & 4-H Summer Camp

- Assist in teaching all components of the summer camp program including canoeing, teams' course, high ropes, climbing wall, recreation, arts and crafts, swimming, tubing, paintball, and archery (training provided).
- Lead campers in daily program classes and activities (wake-up, flagpole, meals, campfire, and wrap-up).
- Perform camp counselor duties including staying with and attending to campers over night while they are at camp.
- Assist with routine cleanup.
- Train in a specialty area to assist as needed with rental group responsibilities.

Qualifications:

- Must have a high school diploma, working towards a college degree.
- Experience working with youth preferred but not required.
- Must have the patience, understanding, flexibility, and energy to work and live with campers and staff.
- Must demonstrate teaching skills and the ability to implement creative "hands-on" teaching methods.
- Must be willing to sacrifice, adapt, and work hard as part of a team pursuing one common goal.

Salary: **\$475-\$525 per week** plus lodging, meals during camp and a sickness/accidental insurance plan.
